Saskatchewan Environment

As of October 16, 2007 418 cases of DED have been confirmed in Saskatchewan. 164 cases of DED have been confirmed by the Crop Protection Laboratory in Regina, while the remainder were diagnosed and marked by Saskatchewan Environment (SE) staff.

There were 60 trees removed from the Regina buffer and 7 trees removed from the Moose Jaw buffer. The Indian Head buffer had 33 trees removed from it in 2007.

SE expanded its surveillance into several provincial parks in 2007. 109 trees have been marked for removal in Echo Valley Provincial Park.

SE surveyed 43 communities as well as maintained cost-share agreements with 40 communities. Two potential cost-share agreements with Wynyard and Wadena will be in negotiation once the provincial election campaign ends on November 7, 2007.
